

WAREHOUSE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Footwear

- Sandals, flip flops, and open toe/heel shoes are not permitted on the warehouse floor. Designated areas have safety shoe requirements.

Pedestrian Traffic

- If walking through the warehouse, stay in designated pedestrian walkways. Be alert of forklift activity, listen for forklift safety horns. Be cautious at intersections and corners. Make eye contact with forklift operators to be sure it's safe to proceed. The pedestrian has the "right of way".

Surroundings

- Be aware of the closest emergency exit when in the warehouse in case of emergency. For your safety, avoid entering the dock areas and do not attempt to operate dock doors or dock leveling plates. Refer any requests for delivery signatures or shipping / receiving activity to warehouse personnel.

Powered Industrial Vehicles

- Only Certified lift truck operators, may operate motorized lifts and material transportation vehicles in the warehouse. Do not stand or ride on pallet jacks, or step on or walk across pallets.

Inventory

- All inventory is location-controlled and accounted for. If you require product for testing or samples, please contact customer service to place an appropriate order to execute an inventory transaction which will relieve the inventory. Coordinate any product removal with the warehouse managers.

Automated Conveyor

- Loose fitting clothing or jewelry is not permitted near the conveyor equipment. These can become entangled in the conveyor system which can cause a significant injury.
